

**What to Take?**  
**Academic Year 2014-2015**  
**MDiv Program**

Students must register for minimum of 12 credits per semester in order to be full-time. Total of 30 credits maximum per year – Fall+Jan+Spring terms combined. Normal load per semester is 13 credits, maximum per semester is 15 credits. It is recommended that entering students enroll in 13 credits.

**Required Courses for Entering MDiv and Dual (MDiv/MA) students**

All entering students must enroll in the following courses for the Fall Semester. (If you plan to apply for advanced placement, assume that you will not receive it and register accordingly.)

<b>OT2101 - Old Testament Orientation</b>	3 credits
<b>SC2101 - Speech Communication in Ministry I</b>	1 credit
<b>TH2100 Systematic Theology (or take in Spring Semester)</b>	3 credits

TH2100 is offered in both the fall and spring semesters, and once the class is full (70 students), all other students must plan to enroll in the spring semester.

**Course highly recommended for all entering MDiv and Dual students**

<b>CH1100 – Survey of Early and Medieval Church History</b>	3 credits

Students with little to no background in the study of theology or philosophy are strongly encouraged to enroll in CH1100 Survey of Early and Medieval Church History, and postpone enrolling in TH2100 Systematic Theology until the spring semester.

**Language Track Study at PTS**

If you are enrolled in Summer Language at Princeton Seminary this summer, you will want to follow your summer language course with a language-based exegesis course.

Hebrew students should enroll in <b>OT3400 Introduction to Exegesis</b>	3 credits
Greek students should enroll in <b>NT3400 Introduction to NT Exegesis</b>	3 credits

If you wish to study Biblical studies in language-based courses and are not currently enrolled in summer language, you may wish to consider enrolling in a language.

<b>OT1151 Hebrew</b> or <b>NT1151 Greek</b>	3 credits
